Honoring Seeds of Hope Award Recipient, Dr. Ana Malinow

Dr. Ana Malinow is Associate Professor of Pediatrics at Baylor College of Medicine and full-time faculty at the Ben Taub General Hospital Pediatric Emergency and Ambulatory Center in Houston. Dr. Malinow's experiences with the underserved in Cleveland and Houston motivated her in 2002 to co-found Health Care for All Texas and to promote single-payer universal health care through education and policy setting. Dr. Malinow is a frequent speaker on health care reform in local and national venues, and has been featured on multiple television and radio programs. She is the author of numerous Op-Ed articles, and is past president of Physicians for a National Health Program, a non-profit research and education organization of 16,000 physicians, medical students, and health professionals who support single-payer national health insurance.

RESULTS is thrilled to have Dr. Joia Mukherjee join us from Boston, where she is Chief Medical Officer for Partners in Health, a non-profit provider of life saving treatment to the poor in the developing world. Board certified in pediatrics, infectious diseases and internal medicine, on staff at Brigham and Women's Hospital, and assistant professor at Harvard Medical School, Dr. Mukherjee is a global leader in the treatment of MDR-TB and HIV/AIDS. A recent Boston Globe article has described her as having an "intriguing quality of being both light-hearted and profound".
